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Introduction

Direct Access of DHL Active Tracing enables you to join directly into the Shipment tracking system and find your search results about your shipments. Everything you have to do is to insert your internet address (URL) and quickly you'll access the corresponding page. This is time efficient and makes it possible to create a direct, automatic link between your application and our **DHL AcT**.

1. Different kinds of searching

There are two different kinds of searching:

1. Search with unique Shipment-ID
2. Search with combined criteria

With the unique Shipment-ID you should normally only receive one result (sometimes it may happen that you receive more than one result).

Searching with combined criteria will normally find more than one result.

1.1 Searching with an unique Shipment-ID

With the following criterion you'll find one concrete shipment.

1. *Package-ID*
2. *Shipment-Number*
3. *Ordercode*

1.2 Searching with combined criteria

If you are looking for some different shipments and you do not know exactly all the codes listed above, you could start with an URL like shown in option 1 or option 2 (see chapter 2).

Within option 1 you will have to fill out the combined criteria.

The following criteria are for option use:

1. *Reference*

The customers order-number for a shipment (e.g. reference-no. or something similar).

2. *Destination-country*

Please fill in the country to where the shipment should be send.

3. *Destination-Zipcode*

Please fill in the zip-code of the destination city.

4. *Pickup-date from*

The earliest pickup-date for the shipment.

5. *Pickupdate to*

The latest pickup-date for the shipment.

2. Description of parameters

2.1 Option 1

2.1.1 Searching with an unique Shipment-ID

The following URL shows the static part of the URL

You are able to complete the URL with the following parameters:

1. &at=package for Package-ID
2. &at=consignment for Shipment-Number
3. &at=order for Ordercode
4. &at=uniqueDatabaseId for internal DHL Database-ID, special usage
5. &a= as number for the Shipment-Id
6. &l=en or l=sv for english, swedish

2.1.2 Searching with combined criteria

The static part of the URL:

You are able to complete the URL with the following parameters:

1. &kr= for Customer reference
2. &el= for Consignee country (ISO code)
3. &eplz= for Consignee Zipcode
4. &av= Pickupdate from (dd.mm.yyyy)
5. &ab= Pickupdate to (dd.mm.yyyy)
6. &l= Language (Filled with en(=english), sv(=swedish))

For a search with for a Customer reference, pickup-date between 01.10.2010 and 16.11.2010:
